## The School

- **National English School** is a co-educational institution established in 2000 at **VIP Road, Baguiati**. Renowned philanthropist, **Sri Sudhir Kumar Saha**, founded the school with the aim to prepare the youngsters of the nation to embark on a journey of academic and personal excellence. Affiliated with the **CISCE, New Delhi**, the school provides a creative curriculum which reflects the interests of our learners.
- The **Rajarhat Campus** of National English School, also affiliated to **CISCE**, was inaugurated by Dr. Asim Dasgupta, Hon'ble Finance Minister, Govt. of West Bengal in February 2008.
- National English School (Primary), **Desbandhu Nagar Branch** has obtained a NOC from the Dept. of Education, Govt. of West Bengal.
- In the year 2017, the NES Educational Trust has come up with an avantgarde facility for teacher training at Rajarhat, christened **National College of Education** set in a modern 65 cottahs campus, the B.Ed. and D.El.Ed college, approved by NCTE, Ministry of HRD, Govt. of India, affiliated to WBUTTEPA and WBBPE.
- The foundation stone laying ceremony of another branch, **NES World School**, was recently held at Rajarhat and Kaikhali, that aims to spread education through the exciting and innovative use of technology..
- **Visionary educationist, Mr. Samir K. Saha, our founder Director**, has shaped these institutions with sky-high determination, and a life-long passion to accomplish the dreams of innumerable school.

## MISSION :

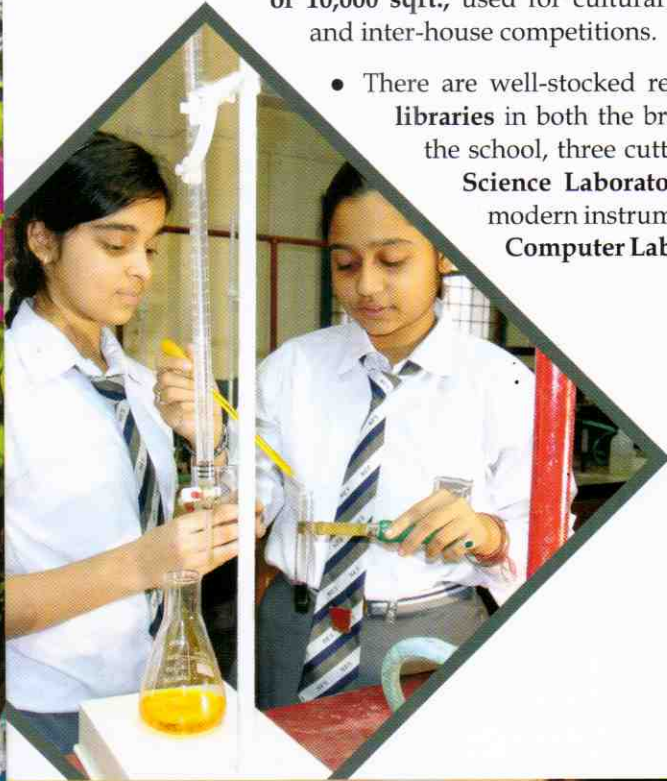
- To provide a stimulating early learning experience which promotes each child's social, emotional, physical, and cognitive development, and builds a foundation for life-long learning.



# Infrastructure

- The VIP Road Branch of the school, a six storied building, has a **4000 sqft. Auditorium** on the top floor, while the Rajarhat Branch offers an **Auditorium of 10,000 sqft.**, used for cultural activities and inter-house competitions.

- There are well-stocked resourceful **libraries** in both the branches of the school, three cutting-edge **Science Laboratories** with modern instruments, two **Computer Laboratories**



with more than 100 computers with upgraded software packages and **Wi-Fi facilities**.

- **CCTV Cameras** are installed in every classroom to check the progress of the students.
- **All the branches of the school**, as well as the **National College of Education**, have installed **Solar Panels** as an alternative source of energy.
- A **Parents' App** has been launched to enable the parents to monitor their child's class assignments, attendance reports, etc.

## E-LEARNING :

- The school is ready to face all the challenges with its e-learning program. It introduced **online classes on Microsoft Teams** during the pandemic, along with regular **audio-visual classes**, which turned out to be a great success.
- The **Green Campus** – a unique initiative of the school, helps the guardians to stay in touch with their child's learning and development.

## NES JUNIOR :

- The junior school abides by a **curriculum** that is **child-friendly** which is updated and modified regularly to suit the individual nature of a child.

- The school offers unique learning experiences to students through the variety of laboratories - **Science Laboratories, Computer Laboratories, Home Science Laboratories**.





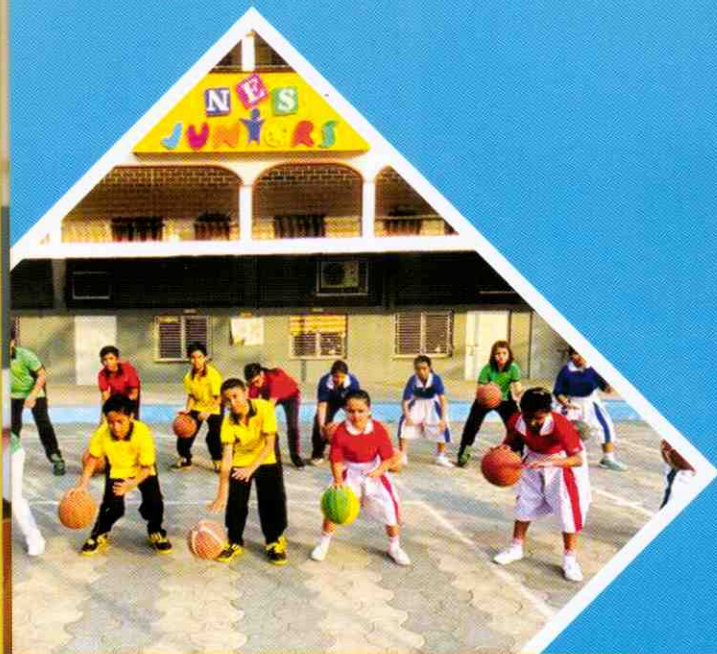
## Academic Session

Our Academic Session is from April to March. We have two Unit Tests and the Mid Term Examination prior to the Annual Examination held towards the end of the academic year. We believe that success and discipline go hand in hand and underpin this by setting exceptionally high expectation in relation to attendance, punctuality, behaviour and effort.

## Admissions

Admission forms along with the school prospectus are issued from the school office on and from 1st September. Forms should be submitted within in 7 days of collecting it. Admission will be granted on the basis of performance of the candidate in the interview for nursery classes and in written test and interview for class 1 and above. Candidates will be examined on the syllabus of the class immediately below that to which they seek admission. Both parents/guardians will be required to attend an interview. The following documents are required to be submitted with the admission form :

- 1) Duly attested photo copy of Municipal Corporation or Hospital /Nursing Home Birth Certificate.
- 2) One recent passport size colour photograph of the candidate.
- 3) Transfer Certificate for admission to class II to VIII, issued from a school (recognized by the Education Dept., Govt. of West Bengal) by the candidate last attended.
- 4) Admission to Class XI requires approval from the Council for The Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi.
- 5) In the case of all Inter-state transfer candidates, the Transfer Certificate must be countersigned by the Education Officer of the State concerned. Transfer cases are taken into special consideration.

The school has an ongoing faculty training and staff inset programme organized in conjunction with our B.Ed college project 'National College of Education'.







## Harvest

The school publishes a yearly School Magazine named "Harvest", which provides an encouraging platform to

showcase the student's literary and creative ideas in a vibrant and colourful canvas.

## Parent-teacher Meeting

The school keeps a constant touch with the parents through the school diary. Besides this, regular parent-teacher meetings are held to exchange views for the desired improvement of the concerned ward and facilitate regular and transparent communication between parents,

## Counselling & Health Check-up

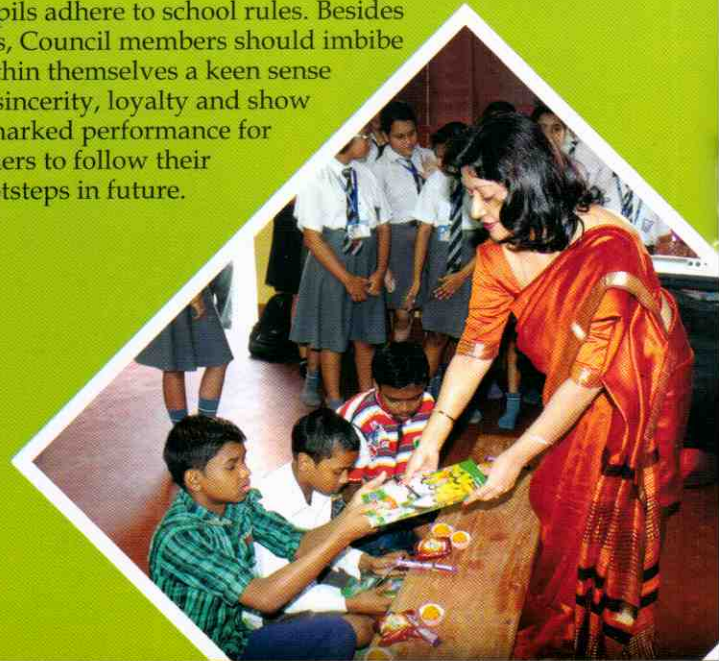
The Students of National English School are divided into four houses. Each house has a House Captain and a mentor who helps to organise inter-house competitions effectively. Houses with various colours are named as follows :

# Activities
