

We have a strong track record in academics which is reflected in our outstanding board results. In ISC examinations, our class XII topper Aditi Jhunjhunwalla was awarded by the Chief Minister of West Bengal for excellent Result and all our students have scored above 60% with a class average of 83% in ISC and 86% in ICSE. Our class XII topper Ritwika Hazra scored 99% and secured 2nd rank in state and 4th rank in India in ISC, 2016. These impressive results are a testament to the hard work and dedication of our highly-experienced faculty who are committed to ensuring that each and every student at NES excels, and leaves our school as motivated, responsible and confident young adults, not afraid to chase their dreams.

At the heart of our success is our constant endeavour to make learning interesting, enjoyable and stimulating. ### SMART CLASS (E- LEARNING)

The School has introduced digital classes termed 'SMART CLASS'. The idea is that classes are conducted through Audio Visual aids and the content is displayed on the huge wall mounted Touch Screen Interactive Display System linked to the school's server. The Package includes specially tailored class-wise and subject-wise programmes for the students, which boosts them to go beyond conventional teaching through text books and makes the subject matter much more attractive. These interactive lessons help the students to understand the concepts through video clippings, 3D diagrams and simulated experiments. Animated pictorial representation helps the teachers to easily explain difficult concepts to the students.

### JUNIOR SCHOOL

The Junior School is a period of preparation, equipping each child with the skills and knowledge required for entering Senior School. The Students are introduced to a





world of new ideas, concepts and experiences. The training given during this period encompasses an enormous sphere of activities, which provides innumerable opportunities to hone the child's capabilities and talents. While the process involves learning through experience and activity, due emphasis is also given to formal text book education. ### SENIOR SCHOOL



# **Academic Session**

# **Admissions**

Admission forms along with the school prospectus are issued from the school office on and from 1st September. Forms should be submitted within in 7 days of collecting it. Admission will be granted on the basis of performance of the candidate in the interview for nursery classes and in written test and interview for class 1 and above. Candidates will be examined on the syllabus of the class immediately below that to which they seek admission. Both parents/guardians will be required to attend an interview. The following documents are required to be submitted with the admission form:

- 1) Duly attested photo copy of Municipal Corporation or Hospital / Nursing Home Birth Certificate.
- 2) One recent passport size colour photograph of the candidate.
- 3) Transfer Certificate for admission to class II to VIII, issued from a school (recognized by the Education Dept., Govt. of West Bengal) by the candidate last attended.
- 4) Admission to Class XI requires approval from the Council for The Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi.
- 5) In the case of all Inter-state transfer candidates, the Transfer Certificate must be countersigned by the Education Officer of the State concerned. Transfer cases are taken into special consideration.



showcase the student's literary and creative ideas in a vibrant and colourful canvas.


# Parent-teacher Meeting


The Students of National English School are divided into four houses. Each house has a House Captain and a mentor who helps to organise inter-house competitions effectively. Houses with various colours are named as follows:
